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- 22 Having purified your souls by obedience to the truth for a sincere love of the brethren, fervently love each other from a pure heart.

  23 You have been born again not out of perishable seed, but imperishable: through the living and enduring Word of God.

  24 FOR ALL FLESH IS LIKE GRASS AND ALL OF HER GLORY IS LIKE A FLOWER OF GRASS. THE GRASS WITHERS AND THE FLOWER FADES,

C. Resist Your Sinful Temptations (2:1) "What am I putting?"
1. The Greek verb <i>apotith</i> ēmi (ἀποτίθημι) was literally used of taking off
2. What things are we to "take off" or "remove?"
a. "All Malice" = $kakia$ ( $\kappa\alpha\kappa\iota\alpha$ ) - a general word used for all sorts of evil behavior
b. "All Deceitfulness" = dolos (δόλος) was used in hunting ("To trap with bait")
c. "Hypocrisies" = hupocrisis (ὑπόκρισις)
d. "Envies" (cf. 1 Cor. 3:3; Matt. 27:18; Exo. 20:17)
e "All Slander" = katalalian (καταλαλιάς)
D. Renew Your Spiritual Hunger (2:2) "What is in my Mouth?"
