(prognosis / προγνωσις) (2) Sanctified by the Spirit (1:2b) (a) "hagiosmos (άγιασμος) basically means to be set apart as holy (3) Saved for Service by the Son (1:2c) (a) The "obedience" of faith b. Parenthesis: Satisfaction in the Trinity (1) Defined: "God is One as to Essence, Three as to Person" (2) The Trinity in History (3) Three Essential Elements of the Triunity of God (a) Pillar #1 - God is One as to Essence (God is One in Unity) (b) Pillar #2 - God is Three as to Person (God is Three in Distinction, but not separation) (c) Pillar #3 - Each Person is Fully God (God is Complete in Each Person)
