

"A Royal Priesthood" (Part 5)

1 Peter 2:6b-8

4 And coming to Him as the Living Stone, having been rejected by men-but chosen by God and precious [to Him]. 5 You also, as living stones, are being built up as a spiritual house for a holy priesthood to offer up spiritual sacrifices acceptable to God through Jesus Christ. 6 For it is contained in Scripture: Behold, I Lay in Zion a chosen stone, a PRECIOUS CORNERSTONE; AND THE ONE WHO BELIEVES IN HIM WILL NEVER BE PUT TO SHAME. 7 This honor, therefore, is for you who believe. But for those who disbelieve: THE STONE WHICH THE BUILDERS REJECTED, THIS BECAME THE CHIEF CORNER. 8 And: A STONE OF STUMBLING AND A ROCK OF OFFENSE. They stumble because they are disobedient to the word, unto which [ends] they were appointed. **9** But you are AN ELECT RACE, A ROYAL PRIESTHOOD, A HOLY NATION, A PEOPLE FOR [God's own] Possession so that you might proclaim the excellencies of Him who called you out of darkness into His marvelous light. **10** Once you were not a people, but now [you are the] people of God; [once you were] those who had not received mercy, but now you have received mercy.

- a. The word "shame" (or "disappointed") is from the Greek verb $kataisxun\bar{o}$ ($\kappa\alpha\tau\alpha\iota\sigma\chi\nu\nu\omega$) "being deceived in some confidence, or placing hope in someone and having that hope dashed"
- (1) What is the specific context in which Peter writes? Cf. 3:14-17
- 3. The Contrast of Unbelief (7-8a)
 - a. Translation Issue:

KJV - Unto you therefore which believe he is precious

NIV - Now to you who believe, this stone is precious.

RSV - To you therefore who believe, he is precious,

ESV - So the honor is for you who believe

NASB - This precious value, then, is for you who believe.
