 - a. Example of a fictional chiasm (note how it follows the front edge of the X):
 - <u>A</u> Today we will celebrate God's goodness
 - \underline{B} We will worship in song
 - <u>C</u> We will hear God's Word
 - **<u>B</u>** We will sing praises to His name
 - A Today we will celebrate God's goodness
