CONCERCICE CONCERCICE

12 Beloved, do not be surprised at the fiery ordeal among you, which comes upon you for your testing, as though some strange thing were happening to you. 13 But in the degree you share in the sufferings of Christ, keep on rejoicing so that also at the revelation of His glory you may rejoice with exultation. 14 If you are reviled for the name of Christ, you are blessed, for the Spirit of glory and of God rests upon you. 15 Let none of you suffer as a murderer or a thief or an evil doer or a busybody. 16 But if [any of you suffers] as a Christian, let him not be ashamed, but in that name let him glorify God.

17 For [it is] time for judgement to begin from the house of God; and if [it begins] with us first, what will [be the] end of those who are disobedient to Gospel of God? **18** And, IF IT IS WITH DIFFICULTY THAT THE RIGHTEOUS IS BEING SAVED, WHAT WILL BECOME OF THE UNGODLY AND THE SINNER? **19** Therefore, let those also who suffer according to the will of God entrust their souls to a faithful Creator in doing good.

Five characteristics of persevering faith: 1) *Results in Joy* (6a); 2) *Stands the Test of Trials* (6b-7); 3) *Loves The Lord (whom we have not seen)* (8a); 4) *Believes in The Lord (whom we don't see)* (8b); 5) *Is the Means to Final Salvation* (9)

An emphasis that we see time and again is that our suffering must not be caused by our own sinful actions (2:12; 2:19-20; 3:9-12; 3:13-14; 3:16-17; 4:15-16).
